VOCALS/SINGING

30 min per week. Fee: €160 for 10 sessions.

45 min per week. Fee: €240 per 10 sessions.

Classes are held daily from Monday to Saturday.

Sessions are held by appointment.

Please contact the school should any further information be required.

Our one-to-one singing lessons are designed to meet the individual needs of the student. Complete beginners learn basic vocal technique and how to approach song interpretation, whilst more experienced singers can work to improve their technique and expand their repertoire.

Students can opt to take Trinity College London Examinations leading up to Diploma Level which are fully accredited by the MQC. These students will also be given aural training and work on their sight reading/musical knowledge.

Students for individual singing lessons will be assessed before acceptance.

Different styles of tuition are offered from Musical Theatre to Rock & Pop as well as Classical.

Students will be assigned to a tutor to suit their style based on the initial assessment.

VIOLIN

30min per week - €150 for 10 sessions.

45min per week - €225 for 10 sessions.

Or small groups (if available) - €120/term.

Sessions held by appointment.

Violin lessons are held on an individual basis and will include a variety of different aspects, from learning how to properly hold the violin and use of the bow, to understanding and mastering this instrument. There will be a focus on musicality, appreciating different genres, styles and concepts as well as learning music theory and how to read music notation. These lessons can prepare you for optional Trinity College London examinations.

PIANO/KEYBOARDS

30min per week. Fee: €150 for 10 sessions.

45min per week. Fee: €225 for 10 sessions.

Masquerade offers classes in piano and electronic keyboard. Whether you want to prepare for Trinity College London Exams or pursue your music passion for pleasure, we're here for you.

We offer lessons in classical piano (students can follow a path towards the exams with the obligatory theory classes twice a month or just learn how to play piano for their enjoyment) and in electronic keyboard with the new exciting Rock&Pop syllabus from Trinity College London.

GUITAR

30min per week. Fee: €150 for 10 sessions.

45min per week. Fee: €225 for 10 sessions.

Sessions held by appointment.

Guitar will cover a wide range of styles and techniques ranging from Fingerstyle, Classical, Spanish, Rock, Acoustic, Blues and more. The guitar serves as a vehicle for personal expression whilst at the same time developing fine motor skills and complex co-ordination. It promotes discipline, responsibility and commitment to working towards a goal. Above all else, guitar lessons will transmit a skill that can be shared with and appreciated by others.

DRUMS

30min per week. Fee: €150 for 10 sessions.

45min per week. Fee: €225 for 10 sessions.

Sessions held by appointment.

Drum lessons will include a variety of different aspects of drumming; from learning how to properly hold the sticks to understanding and applying ergonomic techniques and mastering the kit. The sessions will focus on musicality, history, solfège, reading and writing, improvisation, how to listen, appreciating different genres, styles and concepts as well as also learning how to read music notation. The lessons will be held in our fully equipped sound studio at M Space. (The room kit is also available to be hired out by any students and other drummers who wish to practice by the hour).
